As part of Londonderry’s 35th Anniversary, we continue our commitment to giving back to the community that has supported us for decades. In May, we are proud to support For All Seasons and their Military Family Mental Health Access campaign.

Statistics show that 1 in 4 Eastern Shore residents is connected to the military, whether as a service member, veteran, or immediate family member. This makes supporting military-connected individuals especially meaningful in our community.

For All Seasons provides critical mental health services tailored specifically to veterans and their families. In just the third quarter of 2025, their clinicians served over 350 military-connected individuals, including 114 children.

Donations to this campaign help ensure access to:

- Same-day counseling services
- 24/7/365 crisis support hotlines
- Culturally informed care for those who have served

Notably, 100% of their clinical team is certified in Maryland military assistance, strengthening their ability to provide specialized care and suicide prevention support.

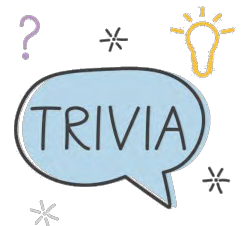
