Recyclable

These items can be recycled in one container with All-in-One Recycling

Paper

- Paper (staples okay)
- Newspaper
- Envelopes
- Junk Mail
- Phone Books
- Brochures
- Magazines

Plastic

- Water bottles
- Take-out containers
- Soda bottles
- Bagged firm plastics

Glass

- Bottles (clear, green and brown)
- Jars

Cardboard

- Ream wrappers
- File folders
- Posterboard
- Frozen food boxes
- Cardboard boxes
- Milk cartons

Metal

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Food cans
- Scrap metal
- Some small appliances

Special handling

These items should never be mixed with regular recycling and require special handling. Learn more at RepublicServices.com

- Incandescent light bulbs
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Computers and Electronics
- Needles or syringes
- Hazardous Waste
- Paint
- Toxic material containers

Special handling

- Aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil
- Batteries
- Food waste
- Glass
- Mirrors or ceramics
- Stickers and address labels
- Styrofoam
- Tissue, paper towels or napkins
